

Visit by Municipal Engineers from Karnataka State Municipal Corporation on 20th November 2014

A group of Municipal Engineers from various parts of Karnataka were given orientation on the Municipal Solid Waste Management programme. This orientation programme was conducted at Tambaram on the 20th November 2014 under the leadership of the Regional Director for Municipal Administration Ms. Prema. There were about 50 members in the group of Municipal Engineers.

As part of the orientation programme, the group of members visited the Pammal Solid Waste Management programme and the Resource recovery centre at Vishwesapuram. The members were oriented on the Swatch-1 machine, which works on the magnetic combustion method without power, the Model biogas plant and the Briquetting machine. Later the vermicomposting techniques using windrow method and the culture of worms were explained to them by the Managing Trustee, Ms. Mangalam Balasubramanian. Other products such as Plastic upcycling product and recyclables segregation were kept on display.
